This past year I received a bottle of *Truly Joyful* perfume for my birthday. It's sitting on my dresser, and it's a daily visual reminder for me to check my heart attitude before I leave my room in the morning. Does my life reflect the joy of the Lord? Psalm 16:11 reminds us, "You make known to me the path of life; in your presence there is *fullness of joy*; at your right hand are pleasures forevermore." One key to being truly joyful is spending time in God's presence. Joy is also a fruit of the Spirit (Galatians 5:22). In the meantime, Miriam is still teaching middle school Bible remotely, and Todd is working to promote Faith Academy around the world, developing relationships with alumni, former staff, and ministry partners. Your continued prayers for strength to finish the school year well would be appreciated. Preparing for asynchronous classes and the 12-hour time difference can be exhausting. Lord willing, our new plan is to return to the Philippines in early August for the 2021-22 school year.

The extensive restrictions in the Philippines over the past year have

greatly impacted Hillcrest Christian Church and Lyncrest Christian Academy (LCA), where Miriam taught part time the last five years. Church attendance is presently limited to 10% capacity. LCA is providing online education but to less than half of last year's enrollment. Students have not been allowed to leave their homes in over a year. Please pray for the school's dedicated teachers, students, and families as they face many challenges.

Joshua and Katrina were able to spend spring break and Easter with us. Our protracted stay in the States has come with so many blessings as we have had opportunities to spend extra time with our children, extended family, and friends. We've also been able to attend our commending assembly, Westlake Bible Fellowship. And for the first time in eight years, we're experiencing an Ohio spring. We're really enjoying walking in our neighborhood and seeing the beautiful flowers and budding trees. While the beginning of 2021 has taken on a different look from what we anticipated, we can join with the psalmist and say, "you have been my help, and in the shadow of your wings I will sing for joy" (Psalm 63:7)! Our hearts are truly joyful!!
