Ten Years of Ministry

Beautiful Gate Special School is celebrating its tenth year of service to children with special needs. Beautiful Gate first opened in January 2007 with three students



and three teachers, holding classes in the kitchen and living room of a small house.


Now, ten years later, about 15 teachers serve approximately 30 students in three different locations around



our city and we are launching a fourth location this June. Sometimes, we are overwhelmed when we think back over the years and what God has done.

Over the past ten years, we have served an estimated 60 students, of which about 30 remain. Some students have left our school due to their parent's family obligations or work requirements but, some have gone on to "normal" schools because they are high functioning. Sadly, one young girl died but, our greatest joy comes from the students that have been with us for many years.

Amazingly, one of the original three students that we started with, in 2007, is still attending Beautiful Gate.



His name is Sujay and he is now 19 years of age. His best friend, Sumanth, has been with us almost as long, about nine years, and just celebrated his 21st birthday.



New Year / Same Old Vision

Last year, I recall writing our first newsletter of 2016 with the heading "New Year / Old Vision." I went on to write that after completing the construction and dedication of our new Beautiful Gate facility in 2015, we felt God was re-igniting in us an old desire to open satellite schools around the city of Mysore. In June of 2016 we launched our third branch of Beautiful Gate on the south side of our city and, now, we want to stick with that same "old vision" by launching a fourth branch on the west side in June of 2017.



The Bible college and seminary where I have been teaching part-time for the last several years has given us permission to use one of their dormitories for the next two years. The hall is large and well suited for our needs but will require some minor repairs to make it safe for the students.



We will start the school with our teachers and students who are living near the new location. This will eliminate some of the cost we currently incur for transportation. Additionally, it will free up some seats for new students to attend classes at our main campus.

Land Conversion

The land on which Beautiful Gate is situated is zoned agricultural. It was a coconut and tamarind farm when we purchased it in 2006.



Over the last few years, we have been able to make developments to the land and many of you remember the testimony of how God miraculously provided for the school building that we now occupy.



However, because of the current agricultural status of the land, we are limited in the amount of development that we can undertake. A single farmhouse (Beautiful Gate is built in the shape of a farmhouse), borewell and perimeter fence is about the limit of what we can development without incurring large fines and penalties.

We strongly feel that God is leading Beautiful Gate into a season of growth and that the time for converting this land to non-agricultural status is now. Trusting ourselves to the faithfulness of God, we have started the conversion process, which may take up to six months.

Land Conversion Cont.

The Indian government has deliberately made the conversion of agricultural land a tedious and expensive process to minimize the loss of farmland in India. Please help us pray for favor in the eyes of the government officials and that the fear of the Lord would overshadow their decisions (2 Chronicles 19:7). Also, please help us pray that God would make provision for the funds needed at each stage of the conversion process.
