It was a busy time in Coyhaigue, Aysen and Talcahuano, as over 25,000 Seed Sowers texts were given out from door to door with the help of a nice group of young people. An encouraging number of people responded to the invitations and attended the gospel meetings. God blessed His Word, and we heard of some confessing Christ as Saviour. Back here at home, we had the joy of baptizing 3 women in April, and they are now part of the assembly. Many relatives and friends were out to witness their baptism, and heard the gospel preached clearly. In May, we had a special get-together for the young people that helped us during the summer. All were encouraged and challenged to continue sowing the Good Seed all year round.
