The Friday evening Bible study at the White Rock Leisure Centre continues to be blessed with unsaved drawn by the LORD and sometimes the study is changed to a Gospel meeting if the numbers are high.

As we continue to seek the LORD about establishing a school of evangelism and discipleship in W. Belfast God continues to prepare these saints for reaching W. Belfast. God recently provided a gift towards the purchase of a laptop, portable projector and screen for teaching in W. Belfast and the proposed school. NASB Study Bibles and 4 titles of book (16 books, 4 study Bibles total) were also provided for discipleship of those who get saved in W. Belfast.

At this time, prayer is needed for Conor, Barry, Deborah, Darragh, and Christina, as I train them for Biblical Counselling as well as the subjects for the proposed school of evangelism and discipleship. We had a blessed time together at our home for our first training session three weeks ago. With families, jobs, and the work, time and discipline are a great need in their lives for the undertaking of the training. We can share this word of encouragement for you all. They would like for you to know how encouraged and thankful they are to know that you are praying for them and for the LORD's provision for the work in W. Belfast. Please pray much for the printing of the booklet by James McCarthy called The Mass: From Mystery To Meaning; as we are running low and for the printing of Gospel tracts for the doors and streets of W. Belfast. Pray much for the impact that Pauline has upon these dear saints who are not that old in the LORD; especially the sisters.

We need prayer for the Biblical Counselling ministry at our home. Lives are being blessed of the LORD and transformed through the word and prayer amidst their struggles and to God be the glory! The Lord continues to present opportunities for the Gospel with the visiting nurses who change the bandages on my legs as well as the carers. Chuck is about to be changed to compression stockings only and after three to six months of no ulcers, the two hip replacements will go ahead. Pray for the preparation of the hearts of the people encountered during that time period to believe the Gospel and be discipled. We also need prayer for a vehicle that would accommodate Chuck for His height and disability, as the smaller ones are not logistically viable. He has to have ambulance transport to and from hospital appointments.

Please pray much for the potential opportunities of discipleship that are being considered by young brothers whom Chuck has been sharing of the command and need of discipleship in this Province. The issue of discipleship is starting to gain ground through personal contact and Biblical challenge.
