



Greetings from a rainy, Kwara Tegi, Niger! The last of the rainy season is finishing up and farmers are bringing in donkey carts full of millet and beans. Pray for a bountiful harvest spiritually too! It is truly amazing to see all that the Lord is doing in hearts and lives here beginning with us and then flowing out to a world who does not yet know Him.

Over the summer months, as children are on vacation from school, we have been doing day camps in the village. We have been inviting the kids to come that we are hanging out with through the week. It is similar to a vacation bible school. They play games, do art projects, music class, sports and have a gospel based bible story. It has gone very well and limits the number of kids which allows us to better invest in individual kids.

Recently, we had a team here from Greenville. They were able to help out in many areas like, day camps and kid's clubs, as well as getting reliable internet up and running. They also came to dub the King of Glory movie into the Zarma language. This is one of the few films in Zarma. Everyone here loves to watch movies and they will watch movies in languages that they don't even understand. The people that we have shared clips with were excited to see a movie in a language they can understand. The Lord was super gracious and gave us a great narrator and allowed us to work out all the bugs quickly. The whole film was recorded and dubbed in 10 days! We are planning to open up the center to show this film for everyone next week. Pray that the Lord would work in hearts this week and prepare them for His truth that is brought out in this movie. It will be a great tool for many years to come and we are looking forward to seeing how the Lord will use it for His glory.



Currently we are seriously praying and working toward a new avenue of ministry here in Kwara Tegi. The Lord has laid Diffa on our hearts. Diffa is a war torn region on the eastern side of Niger that has suffered the blunt of the Boko Haram attacks. There have been conflicting reports about the numbers of refugees displaced by Boko Haram, but a conservative estimate is in the ballpark of 500,000. This is already an area that is plagued with famine and malnutrition. Regardless of the exact number there are also thousands of orphans who have lost their parents in Boko Haram conflicts. The Lord has laid on our heart to start an orphanage in Kwara Tegi for the orphans of Diffa. The Lord has confirmed this in our hearts by allowing the government to be incredibly useful in helping us get it started. Still much to plan and pray through, please pray with us for wisdom. We are also planning a trip out to the refugee camps to get a better vision on how we can share the Love of Jesus there. Pray for those displaced by Boko Haram.



Kids Clubs continue to go well and we usually have around 200 kids. Over the next couple of months, we will be working on adding another level to the amphitheater and also building a roof over it. That will allow us to fit more people in and keep them out of the sun. Continue praying for open hearts to hear the Gospel and for growth and discipleship for those that already know the Savior.

1. Pray that the Lord would guide and direct as we work through orphanage plans.
2. Pray the Lord would continue to work in the hearts and minds of the kids that come to the Youth Center.
3. Pray for the activities at the Youth Center; kids club, art class, music class, sports programs and education programs.
